ORDINANCE NO. 11-155, 1-94

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO REGULAR BSDO's ALBERTO GABRIEL AND LEONARDO PERMA OF BARANGAY PALTOK WHO SUSTAINED AND SUFFERED SERIOUS PHYSICAL INJURIES WHILE IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THEIR DUTIES, IN THE AMOUNT OF SEVENTY-TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P72,000.00) TO BE TAKEN/CHARGED AGAINST THE APPROPRIATION FOR GRANTS, SUBSIDIES, AND CONTRIBUTIONS UNDER THE 1994 ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR OR FROM SUCH OTHER OFFICES WHERE FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE.

WHEREAS, Alberto Gabriel and Leonardo Perma are legitimate Barangay Security & Development Officers (BSDO's) of Barangay Paltok;

WHEREAS, BSDO's Alberto Gabriel and Leonardo Perma while responding to a call for emergency assistance on the night of June 19, 1993 were stabbed by one Avelino Flores alias Boy Abe and had to be rushed to the NCU Hospital where they were both pronounced in serious condition;

WHEREAS, BSDO's Alberto Gabriel and Leonardo Perma are in urgent need of financial assistance to defray the cost of major surgical operations and other medical and hospitalization expenses;

NOW, THEREFORE,
