AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING STANDARD SET OF CLOTHING UNIFORM FOR ALL APPOINTIVE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES AND ALLOCATING AN ADDITIONAL AMOUNT OF TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) EVERY YEAR FOR THE REQUIRED NEW SET OF UNIFORM.

WHEREAS, there is a need to prescribe a standard uniform for all employees working in the Quezon City Government for proper identification;

WHEREAS, it has been an observation that other departments of the Quezon City Government adopt different uniform from each other;

WHEREAS, the adoption of a standard set of uniform creates identity and responsibility among the employees;

WHEREAS, clothing allowance has been provided to defray the cost of the prescribed uniform;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. A standard set of clothing uniform for all Quezon City appointive government officials and employees is hereby prescribed.

SECTION 2. All Quezon City government officials and employees are hereby required to wear a standard set of uniform, style, design and color, the same shall be that as approved by the City Council.
