WHEREAS, Section 2(1), Article XIV of the 1987  
Constitution provides that the State shall establish,  
maintain and support a complete, adequate and integ-  
rated system of education relevant to the needs of  
the people and society;

WHEREAS, Section 3(2), Article XIV of the Consti-  
tution provides that the State is mandated to encourage  
critical and creative thinking, and promote vocational  
efficiency;

WHEREAS, the City Government recognizing education  
as a potent force for development aims to enhance the  
existing educational processes and introduce innova-  
tive approaches to meet the needs of industry and  
national development by the year 2000;

WHEREAS, despite the nationalization of the  
public, elementary and secondary schools, there is need  
for local government to institutionalize its support  
system for national education program for the benefit  
of Quezon City residents;
