ORDINANCE NO. SP-132, S-94

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF ALL TOURISM-ORIENTED AND TOURISM-RELATED BUSINESS IN QUEZON CITY AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Section 17 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that aside from the regular powers and duties vested in them, said local government units shall likewise discharge the functions and responsibilities of national agencies and officers devolved to them pertaining to basic services and facilities;

WHEREAS, such basic services and facilities include, among others, the regulatory powers of the Department of Tourism over the operation and maintenance of tourism-oriented and tourism-related establishments; such as cafes, restaurants, beerhouses, hotels, inns, pension houses, lodging houses, and other similar establishments, including tourist guides and transports; (Section 458-4-iv, Ivid);

WHEREAS, to insure the efficient and effective operation and maintenance of all tourism-oriented and tourism-related establishments, it is imperative to provide such rules and regulations as may be necessary for their governance;
