AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 2 AND 3 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. SP-61, S-93, "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A QUEZON CITY MEDICAL CARE PROGRAM (QC-MEDICAP)", SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SAME AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF ONE MILLION PESOS (P1,000,000.00) FOR THE PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, Article XIII, Section 11 of the
Constitution provides that:

"Article XIII. DECLARATION OF POLICIES AND
OBJECTIVES.

Section 11 - The State shall adopt an
integrated and comprehensive approach to
health development which shall endeavor to
make essential goods, health, and other
social services available to all people at
affordable cost. There shall be priority for
the needs of indigents, underprivileged,
sick, elderly, disabled, women and children."

WHEREAS, specific guidelines under Section 2 of
Ordinance No. SP-61, S-93 are needed to realize or
implement the MEDICAP where medical help for Quezon City
indigents will be given;

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
