ORDINANCE NO. SP-238, S-94

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING OPERATORS OF ALL BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS OPERATING IN QUEZON CITY TO POST AT CONSPICUOUS PLACES IN THEIR ESTABLISHMENTS THE NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE NOTICES OF DISCOUNT PRIVILEGES/BENEFITS TO DULY REGISTERED AND ACKNOWLEDGED SENIOR CITIZENS AS MANDATED BY REPUBLIC ACT 7432.
