ORDINANCE NO. SP-268, S-95

AN ORDINANCE WITHDRAWING THE AUTHORITY TO THE ERECTION OF A GASOLINE FILLING STATION AT KATIPUNAN AVENUE, CORNER ESCALER STREET, BARANGAY LOYOLA HEIGHTS, QUEZON CITY, WHICH IS INCLUDED UNDER RESOLUTION SP-383, S-94 - "A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL PERMIT TO THE PILIPINAS SHELL PETROLEUM CORPORATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION/ERECTION OF GASOLINE FILLING STATIONS IN VARIOUS AREAS OF QUEZON CITY".

WHEREAS, Pilipinas Shell Petroleum Corporation (PSPC) was granted a special permit for the construction/erection of gasoline filling stations in various areas of Quezon City, one of which was along Katipunan Avenue, corner Escaler Street, Barangay Loyola Heights, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the project applied for by PSPC was a gasoline service station and what was authorized by City Resolution No. SP-383, S-94 was the construction of a gasoline filling station which is different from that defined and distinguished by Executive Order No. 6, S-93:

WHEREAS, the grant of the special use permit was done not in accordance with the procedure laid down by the Quezon City Zoning (SP-22, S-92) Ordinance and article 14 of the Executive Order No. 6, S-93;

WHEREAS, in the application for locational clearance submitted by the PSPC, they denied the existence of a pending criminal/administrative, and/or complaint relative to the proposed project;

WHEREAS, in truth and in fact, an administrative case involving the same project is pending in the Energy Industry Administration Bureau with case No. 93-203;

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
