ORDINANCE NO. SP-296, S-95

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CIVILIANS AND UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS FROM INSTALLING AND USING SIRENS OR BLINKERS IN QUEZON CITY AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, use of devices such as sirens and blinkers insinuates authority and need for urgency;

WHEREAS, there have been reports that public utility jeepneys (PUJ's) and automobiles owned by private citizens use these devices to have access to streets when traffic is heavy;

WHEREAS, there have been reports that syndicates involved in robbery-hold-up and kidnapping cases have utilized these devices in their operations or modus operandi and evasion from the proper authorities apprehension;

WHEREAS, the implementation of this Ordinance would prevent syndicate and unauthorized persons from committing unlawful acts detrimental to the peace and order and to the society at large;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person and/or civilian to install and/or use sirens, blinkers or similar devices in Quezon City without proper authority.

SECTION 2. Coverage - All private vehicles and public utility vehicles (PUJ's) are subject to this Ordinance.
