ORDINANCE NO. SP- 304, S-95

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE RE-CLASSIFICATION/
RE-ZONING OF A CERTAIN PORTION OF BARANGAY STO.
DOMINGO, KNOWN AS BLOCK NO. 454, QUEZON CITY, FROM
LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL ZONE (R1) TO HIGH DENSITY
RESIDENTIAL ZONE (R3) AND GENERAL COMMERCIAL ZONE
(C-2), IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE
QUEZON CITY ZONING ORDINANCE OF 1992.

WHEREAS, the primary tool that is being used to control growth and land use in Quezon City and the NCR is MMC Ordinance No. 81-01 pursuant to P.D. 824 as amended by P.D. 1274;

WHEREAS, today, fourteen (14) years after its promulgation, the MMC Zening Ordinance can no longer be a realistic and reliable tool to control land use due to the rapid trend of urbanization in the area and its environment;

WHEREAS, structural and environmental quality survey conducted by NCR and the Metro Manila Commission showed that many of its areas (Block 454 in Q. C. included) have descripted environmentally to a critical proportion;

WHEREAS, in order to save these environments from degradation, congestion and poor sanitation. Presidential Decree 1983 was issued declaring MMA as an Urban Land Reform Zone;

WHEREAS, P. D. 1893 was amended on 14 of May 1980 by P.D. 1967 specifying the 244 sites in the Metropolitan Manila as AREAS FOR PRIORITY DEVELOPMENT (APD);

WHEREAS, Block No 454, bounded on the North by Don Manuel Aggregado Street, on the South by Calamba Street, on the East by Sto. Domingo Street and on the West by Biak-na-Bato Street was declared as APD No. 26 among the 244 sites identified in the Zone classification as Urban Land Reform Zone;
