AN ORDINANCE RENAMING THE PARK AT JERSEY STREET, TORO HILLS (PROJECT 8), BARANGAY BAHAY TORO, QUEZON CITY, TO DR. VICTORIANO D. DIAMONON PARK.

WHEREAS, names of street, playgrounds, schools, hospitals, health centers and other public places owned by the City government may be changed by the Sanggunian of highly urbanized cities in consultation with the Philippine Historical Commission (now National Historical Institute) as provided for under Sec. 13 (b) of the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the National Historical Institute in its letter dated May 19, 1994 has fully endorsed the passage of an ordinance renaming a park as Dr. V.D. Diamonon Park;

WHEREAS, in Barangay Bahay Toro, Quezon City, Dr. Victoriano D. Diamonon is remembered not only as a former City Councilor but also as a pillar in the community whose unselfish dedication was geared towards the good of the community;

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of Barangay Bahay Toro under Barangay Resolution No. 105, S-94 approved on December 1, 1994 has favorably endorsed the naming of the park at Jersey Street, Toro Hills (Project 8) Bgy. Bahay Toro as Dr. Victoriano D. Diamonon Park; and

WHEREAS, the renaming of the park at Jersey Street, Toro Hills (Project 8), Barangay Bahay Toro, Quezon City to Dr. Victoriano D. Diamonon Park is a fitting tribute to a humble community member and a distinguished public servant;
