ORDINANCE NO. SP. 2104 S-2011

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING AN ADDITIONAL ONE PESO (PHP1.00) TO THE ADMISSION FEES IN ALL CINEMAS IN QUEZON CITY FROM JANUARY 15 TO FEBRUARY 15, 2012, THE PROCEEDS THEREOF TO BE DONATED TO THE QUEZON CITY RED CROSS.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Red Cross is a non-profit organization designed primarily to extend the essential humanitarian services to the under privileged sectors of the society especially within its territorial scope and parameters such as relief assistance to thousands of families affected by certain unfortunate natural disasters and provisions of life sustaining blood to myriad of indigent patients;

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned organization seeks to put into action the said vision through a concrete plan and eventually, into a visible execution;

WHEREAS, this humanitarian vision will only take effect if the organization has adequate means and provisions;

WHEREAS, to show the support of the Quezon City Government, it intends to increase by one peso (1.00) the admission fees in cinemas in the City, the proceeds thereof to be donated to Quezon City Red Cross owing to the celebration of the International Humanitarian Law Month;

WHEREAS, Section 36 of the Local Government Code provides that, "a local government unit, may through its local chief executive and with the concurrence of the sanggunian concerned, provide assistance, financial or otherwise, to such people's and nongovernmental organizations for economic, socially-oriented, environmental, or cultural projects to be implemented within its territorial jurisdiction".

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Admission fees in all cinemas or movie houses in Quezon City are hereby increased by One Peso (Php1.00) from January 15 to February 15, 2012.

SECTION 2. The proceeds of the One Peso (Php1.00) prescribed in Section 1 hereof shall be donated to the Quezon City Red Cross owing to the occasion of the International Humanitarian Law Month.

SECTION 3. The City Treasurer is directed to submit a report of the sum collected to the City Council prior to the release thereof to the Quezon City Red Cross.
