WHEREAS, Hon. Connie S. Angeles' affection and deep concern for the moral regeneration and positive upbringing of our youth has inspired her to produce, host and maintain *Pen Pen de Sarapen*, a multi-awarded youth-oriented talk and variety show, of twelve years;

WHEREAS, Hon. Connie S. Angeles saw the opportunity to serve our undeserved and underprivileged residents and was elected City Councilor representing the Third Legislative District of Quezon City from 1992-1998 which she convincingly won and was consistently ranked number one over all;

WHEREAS, Hon. Connie S. Angeles began her political career as City Councilor, served in various capacities and positions of importance, such as Member, Personnel Selection Board (1995-1998), Chairman of the City Council Committee on Women and Family Affairs (1992-1998), Vice Chairman of the City Council Committee on Health and Handicapped People (1992-1998), Assistant Minority Floor Leader (1994-1995), President Pro-Tempore (1995-1998);

WHEREAS, her achievements and significant contributions towards the upliftment of the residents of Quezon City has landed in the Hall of Fame (1996) for receiving, in three consecutive years, the Quezon City Press Association's Manuel Luis Quezon Bantayog Award as Most Outstanding Councilor and the 1998 Leadership Award from the Metro Manila Philippine Councilor's League;

WHEREAS, the outpouring of support for the Hon. Connie S. Angeles saw her recent election as Quezon City's Vice Mayor - a testament to her excellent and sterling leadership qualities, one that is beyond reproach and hard of duplication;


WHEREAS, on July 28 1998, the City Councilor adopted Resolution No. SP-981, Series of 1998, expressing the Council's abiding faith and unwavering support to the leadership of Hon. Connie S. Angeles as the City's 2nd elected Woman Vice Mayor and Presiding Officer;
