RESOLUTION NO. ~~SP-1085~~ S-1999

A RESOLUTION REMEMBERING THE CENTENNIAL DEATH ANNIVERSARY OF JOSE TORRES BUGALLON, A FILIPINO REVOLUTIONARY SOLDIER AND HERO OF THE BATTLE OF LA LOMA AND ERECTING A MARKER IN HIS HONOR, FOR THE PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, Jose Torres Bugallon was the great Filipino soldier and hero of the Battle of La loma under the leadership of Gen. Antonio Luna who fought to death the American forces on February 4, 1899 until dawn of February 5, 1899;

WHEREAS, he was also the hero of Battle of Talisay, Batangas, and was awarded the highest military medal of San Fernando;

WHEREAS, as aide de camp of Gen. Antonio Luna, he stood fearlessly against the American forces when the Filipino-American war exploded on February 1899;

WHEREAS, it was the troops led by Jose Torres Bugallon which were later known as Torres Bugallon guerillas who temporarily halted the advance of American forces led by Gen. Arthur McArthur to Caloocan, Malabon and Navotas in the historic Battle of La loma, north of Manila, now part of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, as a testament to his bravery and gallantry, Gen. Antonio Luna said of Bugallon when he bled to death due to a gunshot wound, "Rest in Peace, valiant Torres, the hero of our motherland, the bravest among the brave";

WHEREAS, his bravery and martyrdom should always be remembered as one of the heroes of our beloved country and a marker should be constructed in memory of him as hero of the Battle of La loma;

WHEREAS, as the hero of the Battle of La loma which is a part of Quezon City, a marker should be constructed in memory of Jose Torres Bugallon marking his 100<sup>th</sup> year death anniversary and remembering his patriotic deed, courage and bravery at a place most suitable and appropriate as may be designated by the National Historical Institute;
