RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1125 , S-99

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING HIS HONOR, MAYOR ISMAEL A. MATHAY, JR., QUEZON CITY, TO GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO ATTY. MANUEL J. GARCIA, WHO RETIRED AS 2ND ASSISTANT CITY PROSECUTOR OF QUEZON CITY EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 7, 1998, IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (P150,000.00), SUCH AMOUNT TO BE TAKEN FROM THE APPROPRIATIONS OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR UNDER GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS IN THE CITY'S ANNUAL BUDGET FOR CALENDAR YEAR 1999.

WHEREAS, 2nd Assistant City Prosecutor Manuel J. Garcia, retired compulsorily, having reached the age of sixty-five (65) years on November 7, 1998;

WHEREAS, Prosecutor Garcia had rendered a total of twelve (12) years of continuous, dedicated, efficient and competent service as Assistant City Prosecutor;

WHEREAS, prior to his appointment as Assistant City Prosecutor, he was a Citizen Attorney of the Citizens Legal Assistance Office (CLAO), now Public Attorney's Office (PAO), Quezon City District Office, for six (6) years, and was assigned simultaneously in the sala of Regional Trial Court Judge Hernani Cruz Pano and Metropolitan Trial Court Judge Antonio P. Santos;

WHEREAS, Prosecutor Garcia had earned a total of forty (40) years of government service starting as a clerk in the Old Senate, Municipal Secretary, and Auditor of the Commission on Audit (COA);


WHEREAS, consistent with the policy of this august body of giving financial assistance to dedicated, loyal and deserving Prosecutors of the City, it is prayed that the amount of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (P150,000.00) be set aside by the city government for the said purpose;

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to request, as it does hereby request, His Honor, Mayor Ismael A. Mathay, Jr., Quezon City, to grant financial assistance to Atty. Manuel J. Garcia, who retired as 2<sup>nd</sup> Assistant City Prosecutor of Quezon City effective November 7, 1998, in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (P150,000.00), such amount to be taken from the appropriation of the office of the City Mayor under grants, subsidies and contributions in the City's Annual Budget for Calendar Year 1999.
