RESOLUTION NO. ~~SP-185~~, 99

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AMOUNTING TO SIXTY THOUSAND PESOS (P60,000.00) OR SO MUCH AS MAY BE REQUIRED FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) TRICYCLE UNIT TO BE UTILIZED AS A SOURCE OF LIVELIHOOD FOR THE FAMILY OF MR. BERNARD CEREZO OF BARANGAY CENTRAL, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY, FATHER OF QUADRUPLETS WHO WERE BORN ON FEBRUARY 16, 1999, SUCH AMOUNT SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND OTHER GRATUITIES OF THE MAYOR'S OFFICE.

WHEREAS, the sangguniang panlungsod is mandated to enact ordinance, approve resolution and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants;

WHEREAS, Section 458 (5) (xiv) of the Local Government Code provides that every city shall provide for the care of the aged, the sick, abandoned minors, abused children, disabled persons and other needy and disadvantaged persons particularly children and youth below eighteen (18) years of age;

WHEREAS, Mrs. Elizabeth Cerezo, wife of Mr. Bernard Cerezo of 515 Sunflower Street, BIR Road, Barangay Central, District IV, Quezon City gave birth to quadruplets at East Avenue Medical Center on February 16, 1999 and named them Mary grace, Mary Joyce, Mary Rose and Mary Jane;

WHEREAS, Mr. Cerezo is employed as a driver of Barangay Central he works as a part-time tricycle driver to augment the income of his family;

WHEREAS, the city government can help alleviate the plight of these children by providing their father a source of livelihood that will serve as a lasting assistance to secure their future;

WHEREAS, quadruplet birth is not a natural occurrence and it is a privilege on the part of the City government to share in nurturing these God-given gifts, especially when they are born an indigent or poverty stricken couple.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to extend, as it does hereby extend, financial assistance amounting to Sixty Thousand Pesos (P60,000.00) or so much as may be required for the purchase of one (1) tricycle unit to be utilized as a source of livelihood for the family of Mr. Bernard Cerezo of Barangay Central, District IV, Quezon City, father of quadruplets who were born on February 16, 1999, such amount shall be taken from the grants, subsidies and other gratuities of the Mayor's Office.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Social Services Development shall act as the coordinanting body in the implementation of this measure.
