A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE SAN JOSE CREDIT COOPERATIVE FOR THE OCCUPANCY OF A PARCEL OF LAND OWNED BY THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT SITUATED ALONG TINAGAN STREET, BARANGAY SAN JOSE, QUEZON CITY, CONSISTING OF SIXTY-THREE (63) SQUARE METERS, MORE OR LESS, THE SAME TO BE UTILIZED AS THE SITE OF THE SAN JOSE CREDIT COOPERATIVE'S ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE AND STORE.

WHEREAS, the San Jose Credit Cooperative was refused by the Barangay Officials of Barangay San Jose to occupy a sidewalk to be utilized as its office and store;

WHEREAS, the said cooperative was given the chance to look for an alternative site with the assistance of the barangay officials of the aforementioned barangay;

WHEREAS, a city-owned real property was identified as the alternative site for said purpose located along Tinagan Street near Mauban Street, Barangay San Jose;

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of San Jose is supportive of said project of the cooperative and even passed Barangay Resolution No. 003-99 proposing to the City Mayor to grant such privilege of authorizing the said cooperative to occupy a portion of the property located at Tinagan Street, as hereby attached in this resolution;

WHEREAS, local government units are mandated by R.A. 6938, otherwise known as the Cooperative Code of the Philippines to give assistance to cooperatives, financial or otherwise;

WHEREAS, the City Council has the power to regulate the use of streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, bridges, parks and other public places and approve the construction, improvement, repair and maintenance thereof;

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
WHEREAS, the site identified by the Barangay and the San Jose Credit Cooperative is part of an open space, hence within its regulatory power as stated in the preceding paragraph.

NOW, THEREFORE,



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the San Jose Credit Cooperative for the occupancy of a parcel of land owned by the Quezon City government situated along Tinagan Street, Barangay San Jose, Quezon City, consisting of Sixty-Three (63) square meters, more or less, the same to be utilized as the site of the San Jose Credit Cooperative's administrative office and store.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to declare, as it does hereby declare, the property specifically identified and actually utilized as part of the disposable property of the City.
