RESOLUTION NO: SP-1370 S-2000

A RESOLUTION ALLOCATING THIRTY NINE THOUSAND PESOS (P39,000.00) TO PROVIDE IMMEDIATE RELIEF ASSISTANCE TO THE VICTIMS OF FIRE CONSISTING OF SEVENTEEN (17) HOUSE-OWNERS AND FIVE (5) HOUSE RENTERS/SHARERS AT CLEOFAS COMPOUND, BARANGAY BAHAY TORO, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY, THE NECESSARY FUNDS THEREFOR TO BE TAKEN FROM GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS OR FROM ANY OTHER AVAILABLE FUNDS IN THE CITY TREASURY.


WHEREAS, a fire occurred at Cleofas Compound, Barangay Bahay Toro, District I, Quezon City, at around 2:00 a.m. last December 15, 1999, affecting seventeen (17) house-owners and five (5) house-renters/sharers,

WHEREAS, these unfortunate fire victims need the help and assistance of the City government in the form of material assistance such as building materials for the reconstruction of their houses, purchase of food, clothing, etc., in the amount of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) for each house owner and One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) for each house-renter/sharer,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to allocate, as it does hereby allocate, Thirty-Nine Thousand Pesos (P39,000.00) to provide immediate relief assistance to the victims of fire consisting of seventeen (17) house-owners and five (5) house-renters/sharers at Cleofas Compound, Barangay Bahay Toro, District I, Quezon City, the necessary funds therefor to be taken from Grants, Subsidies and Contributions or from any other available funds in the City Treasury
