RESOLUTION NO. SP-T 415 S-2000

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE USE OF A PORTION OF GSIS AVENUE AND GRANTS STREET, GSIS VILLAGE, BARANGAY SANGANDAAN, DISTRICT II, QUEZON CITY, FOR THE OFFICIAL SENIOR CITIZENS' CENTER FOR BARANGAY SANGANDAAN.

WHEREAS, the partially completed Multi-Purpose Hall located at the corner of GSIS Avenue and Grants Street, GSIS Village, Barangay Sangandaan, District II, Quezon City, has been pursued by the Association of Senior Citizens of GSIS Village, Inc. as the official Senior Citizens' Center for Barangay Sangandaan;

WHEREAS, the Association's request for the use of the Multi Purpose Hall was not objected to but was even supported by the Council of Barangay Sangandaan, through Resolution No. 21, S-99, and District II Congressman Dante V. Liban, proponent for the construction of the Hall;

WHEREAS, due to the pressing need for an official address and office space, the Association completed the roofing of the abovementioned building, improved its second floor, and assumed the maintenance of said building and beautification of its premises, thus, spending a substantial amount of its meager resources on a building it does not own, despite the absence of any assurance of the Association's permanent use and occupancy of the same;

WHEREAS, due to the foregoing, the needed space for office, assembly meetings and fellowships, and considering the noble activities of the association such as social services, medical missions and the like, the Quezon City Council deems it wise to grant the Association permanent use of the Multi-Purpose Hall.


NOW, THEREFORE,
