RESOLUTION NO. SP-1456, S:2000

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A MORATORIUM OF THIRTY (30) DAYS ON THE ISSUANCE OF NEW FRANCHISE FOR MOTORIZED TRICYCLE PASSENGER UNITS UNTIL AN INVENTORY IS MADE AND PUBLIC HEARINGS ARE CONDUCTED THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, it has been observed that there are so many applications for new franchise to operate motorized tricycle passenger units and if most of all are granted, it could cause more traffic jams not to mention the fact that it could result in drastic reduction of income due to cutthroat competition;


WHEREAS, the granting of franchise has been going on for years and it is but proper to conduct an inventory in order to determine the actual units operating in each route as well as to find out the number of units that are already retired or damaged beyond repair or totally dilapidated so that on the basis of the above, the actual number of units needed could be properly determined and made the basis for granting or not granting additional unit franchises in the particular route;

WHEREAS, in order to determine further the need for additional units in a particular route, a public hearing for the said purpose should be conducted by the Tricycle Regulatory Board (TRB) with the participation of elected Barangay officials in the route affected together with the accredited NGOs, and Jeepney and Tricycle Operators and Drivers Associations therein.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to call, as it does hereby call, for a moratorium of thirty (30) days of the issuance of new franchise for motorized tricycle passenger units until an inventory is made and public hearings are conducted therefor.
