RESOLUTION NO. SP-1501, 2001

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLAN OF THE UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES (UP) TO ESTABLISH SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY PARKS (S & T PARKS) AT THE UP DILIMAN CAMPUS AND ENDORSING THE SAME TO THE PHILIPPINE EXPORT ZONE AUTHORITY (PEZA) CONSISTENT WITH ITS CLASSIFICATION AS AN INSTITUTIONAL ZONE UNDER THE QUEZON CITY COMPREHENSIVE LAND USE PLAN.

WHEREAS, the University of the Philippines has designated portions of the UP Diliman Campus (about 33% of the total campus area) as Science and Technology Parks (S&T Parks);

WHEREAS, the UP S & T Parks is envisioned as a vehicle that shall transform innovative ideas to successful enterprises and become a resource rich environment where entrepreneurial ventures can take root, incubating companies can develop their potential and established firms can expand their opportunities;


WHEREAS, its establishment as S & T Parks is consistent with the classification of the area as an Institutional Zone under the Quezon City Comprehensive Land Use Plan,

WHEREAS, to implement this Plan, the same has to be endorsed to the Philippine Export Zone Authority for the development of the sites as Special Economic Zones;


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to approve, as it does hereby approve, the establishment of the Science and Technology Parks in certain portions of the UP Campus and designating 163.5 hectares (33% of the campus area) as Science and Technology Parks in two (2) non-contiguous sites namely, S & T North-98.5 hectares along Commonwealth Avenue (Lots 42-C-10); S & T South-65 hectares along CP Garcia Road (Lots 40, 102, 174, 101, 131, 41, 42-C-6) consistent with the Institutional Zone classification of the area under the Quezon City Comprehensive Land Use Plan
