RESOLUTION NO. SP- 1554, S-2001

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY GENERAL HOSPITAL TO USE THE QCGH'S HOSPITAL DEVELOPMENT FUND (HDF) AMOUNTING TO FORTY MILLION PESOS (P40,000,000.00) FOR THE REPAIR/CONSTRUCTION/INSTALLATION OF NEW OPD BUILDING, DIETARY BUILDING, LABORATORY BUILDING, INSTALLATION OF A ONE (1) BED/PASSENGER ELEVATOR, AN AUTOMATIC SPRINKLER SYSTEM, A FIRE ALARM SYSTEM, HEAT AND SMOKE DETECTORS, WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM OF THE MAIN BUILDING, SUBJECT TO GOVERNMENT ACCOUNTING AND AUDITING RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City General Hospital is a 250-bed tertiary, general local government hospital of Quezon City established in 1968 primarily to serve the urban poor of the city and the neighboring municipalities;

WHEREAS, City Council Resolution No. 481, S-2000 was passed during its 75th regular session urging the Quezon City General Hospital to develop and complete its facilities in order to provide total healthcare to the residents of Quezon City especially the underprivileged;

WHEREAS, there is a need to repair/renovate the laboratory building, dietary building and construct a new outpatient department building;

WHEREAS, there is also a need to install a one (1) bed/passenger elevator to carry heavy loads such as patient beds, oxygen tanks and other similar equipments;

WHEREAS, there is a further need to upgrade other hospital facilities to ensure electrical and fire safety such as improvement of electrical entrance and electrical system, installation of automatic sprinkler system, fire alarm system, heat and smoke detectors, and upgrading of water distribution system;

WHEREAS, the City Engineer's Office has submitted an approved agency estimate of Forty Million Pesos (P40,000,000.00) for the scope of work and bill of materials for the development project;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City General Hospital has reserved for accumulated unexpanded allotments and income worth Forty Million Pesos (P40,000,000.00) in its Hospital Development Fund which could be used to fund the development projects;

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the Quezon City General Hospital to use part of its Hospital Development Fund which shall not exceed Forty Million Pesos (P40,000,000.00) to be used in the repair/renovation of the laboratory building, construction of new OPD building, dietary building, installation of one (1) bed/passenger elevator, upgrading of all required hospital's fire and electrical safety facilities and water distribution system of the main building, subject to government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Director of the Quezon City General Hospital shall submit to the City Council a report of all disbursements made pursuant to this resolution immediately after spending the entire subject amount.
