A RESOLUTION URGING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT TO FINANCE THE FEASIBILITY STUDY TO BE CONDUCTED BY THE TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES (TUP) TO DETERMINE THE VIABILITY OF ESTABLISHING THE "EVENING OPPORTUNITY COLLEGE" (TUP-QUEZON CITY) AT E. RODRIGUEZ JR HIGH SCHOOL, LOCATED AT BRGY. N. S. AMORANTO, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY AMOUNTING TO ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THREE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTEEN PESOS (P153,615.00)

WHEREAS, Resolution No. SP-1523, S,-2001 entitled " A resolution urging the Technological University of the Philippines (TUP) to establish an "Evening Opportunity College" (TUP-Quezon City) at the E. Rodriguez Jr. High School, located in District I, Quezon City was duly approved by the Quezon City Council on February 20, 2001;

WHEREAS, before establishing the "Evening Opportunity College" (TUP-Quezon City), TUP requires that a feasibility study be made to determine its viability and potential success;

WHEREAS, a feasibility study is also a standard requirement of TUP's Board of Regent;


WHEREAS, the amount of One Hundred Fifty-Three Thousand Six Hundred Fifteen Pesos (P153,615.00) is needed to cover the expenses in conducting the feasibility study.

NOW, THEREFORE,


