RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2697**, S-2004

A RESOLUTION GRANTING ADDITIONAL SIXTY-FIVE (65) ROUTE MEASURED CAPACITY (RMC) FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTORIZED TRICYCLES FOR HIRE WITHIN THE ROUTE COVERED BY DAMAYAN-MARIBLO-PARAISO TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION (DAMAPATODA), DISTRICT 1, THIS CITY.

WHEREAS, despite the legalization program for colorum tricycle units implemented in 1994, 1996, and 1999, new illegally operating units continue to thrive and proliferate in the city which had deprived legitimate franchise holders in the right income they deserve;

WHEREAS, in attempting to meet such problems, notwithstanding, the number of tricycles established by the Route Measured Capacity (RMC) as the appropriate level of demand, the members of the Quezon City Tricycle Franchising Board, agreed in principle, to legalize all existing unfranchised (colorum) tricycle units in Quezon City by recommending the granting of additional franchises to the Quezon City Council;

WHEREAS, as provided for in Resolution No. 68, S-2004 approved on August 4, 2004 by the Barangay Council of Barangay Mariblo, District 1, this City, requesting the City Council to grant additional Sixty-Five (65) units to DAMAPATODA in order to cater the needs of the constituents of said barangay and for the safety of its passengers, and that, said application for additional units will service more people in the community;

WHEREAS, as provided for in Resolution No. 060, S-2004, approved on August 19, 2004 by the Barangay Council of Barangay Damayan, District 1, this City, requesting for the legalization of all colorum units operating within their barangay;

WHEREAS, as provided for in Resolution 03, S-04 of DAMAPATODA, whereby was adopted by the Board of Directors on August 1, 2004 seeking for the legalization of their sixty-five (65) existing colorums;

WHEREAS, based on the Implementing Guidelines for the Legalization of Colorum Motorized Tricycle Units Operating in Quezon City, endorsement of additional franchises for approval shall be based on the actual inspected units made by the Tricycle Franchising Board (TFB) and Tricycle Regulation Unit (TRU);


WHEREAS, the Quezon City government recognizes the importance of an efficient and affordable transport system for public convenience.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, an additional Sixty-Five (65) RMC for the Operation of Motorized Tricycles for hire within the route covered by Damayan-Mariblo-Paraiso Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (DAMAPATODA), District 1, this City.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that copies of this Resolution be forwarded to all concerned barangays and offices for their information and appropriate action.
