RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2768** S-2005

RESOLUTION GRANTING AN ADDITIONAL TWO HUNDRED FIFTY (250) ROUTE MEASURED CAPACITY (RMC) FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTORIZED TRICYCLES-FOR-HIRE WITHIN THE ROUTE COVERED BY BATASAN HILLS TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION (BATASAN HILLS TODA, DISTRICT II, THIS CITY.

WHEREAS, despite the legalization program for colorum tricycle units implemented in 1994, 1996 and 1999, new illegally operating tricycle units continue to thrive and proliferate in the City which had deprived legitimate franchise holders in the right income they deserve;

WHEREAS, in attempting to meet such problems, notwithstanding, the number of tricycles established by the Route Measured Capacity (RMC) as the appropriate level of demand, the members of the Quezon City Tricycle Franchising Board, agreed in principle, to legalize all existing unfranchised (colorum) tricycle units in Quezon City by recommending the granting of additional franchises to the Quezon City Council;

WHEREAS, as provided for in Resolution No. 179, S-2004, approved on August 14, 2004 by the barangay council of Barangay Batasan Hills, District II, Quezon City, requesting the City Council to grant additional Three Hundred (300) units to Batasan Hills TODA in order to cater the needs of constituents of said barangay and for the safety of its passengers, and that, said application for additional units will service more people in the community;


WHEREAS, as provided for in Resolution No. 01, S-2004 of Batasan Hills TODA, whereby was adopted by the Board of Directors on August 01, 2004, seeking for the legalization of their existing colorums to provide transportation service to other neighboring barangays;

WHEREAS, endorsement of additional franchises for approval shall be based on the Implementing Guidelines for the Legalization of Colorum Motorized Tricycle Units Operating in Quezon City, and on the actual inspected units made by the Tricycle Franchising Board (TFB) and Tricycle Regulation Unit (TRU);

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government recognizes the importance of an efficient and affordable transport system for public convenience.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, an additional Two Hundred Fifty (250) Route Measured Capacity (RMC) for the operation of motorized tricycles-for-hire within the route covered by Batasan Hills Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (Batasan Hills TODA), District II, this City.




