NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge, all business establishments located and operating within the boundaries of Quezon City to report to the City government, through the City's Industrial Relations Office, their manpower needs and vacancies on a quarterly basis or more often as the needs and vacancies arise.
