WHEREAS, Section 2 (1), Article XIV of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that "The State shall establish, maintain and support a complete adequate, and integrated system of education relevant to the needs of the people and society;

WHEREAS, Section 99 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides for the functions of the Local School Board, which among other things is, to serve as an advisory committee to the Sanggunian concerned on educational matters;

WHEREAS, in most public schools, there are students considered to be slow learners in subjects such as reading and mathematics;

WHEREAS, these slow learners should be given special assistance by the authorities concerned to help them with their studies;

WHEREAS, in order to help these slow learners cope with their studies, centers for slow learners in the public schools in Quezon City are needed to be organized;

WHEREAS, these Centers which will provide free remedial classes will greatly help in assisting these slow learners obtain the maximum potential in their performance through more training and more exposure in their subjects.


NOW, THEREFORE,
