## RESOLUTION NO. SP2907S-2005

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION TO AMEND ITS IMPLEMENTING RULES AND GUIDELINES IN THE GRANT OF ELIGIBILITY TO BARANGAY OFFICIALS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to CSC Res. No. 030962 dated September 12, 2003, the Civil Service Commission has updated and fine-tuned all its existing policies in Qualification Standards which are contained in the "Revised Policies in Qualification Standards" which amends MC No.42, s.1998 (Framework for Implementation of Policies in Qualification Standards) and other issuances inconsistent with the policies of the commission;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provision embodied under par. 11, Part V (On Eligibility) of the Revised Policies on Qualification Standards, the Barangay officials eligibility shall be considered appropriate for appointment to first level positions (sub-professional) in the Career Service including those in the fire and jail bureaus, except positions covered by Board laws and/or those that require other special eligibilities or determined by the commission or those that require licenses such as those positions listed under category IV of CSC MC 11, s. of 1996 as amended.

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to request, as it does hereby request, the Civil Service Commission to amend the provision embodied under par.11 Part V (On Eligibility) of the Revised Policies of Qualification standards by including in the same paragraph the following:

"that those barangay officials who are graduate of any bachelor's degree (4 year course) shall be granted eligibility appropriate for appointment to second level positions (Career Professional) in the Career Service.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished the Hon. Commissioner of the Civil Service Commission, through the Regional Director, Quezon City, for their information, consideration and favorable action.
