RESOLUTION NO. SP- 29 42 , S-2005

A RESOLUTION URGING THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT (CPD) AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY (DPOS) TO FORMULATE TIGHTER SECURITY MEASURES IN ALL COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS, SCHOOLS AND OTHER PLACES WHICH ARE POTENTIAL TARGETS OF URBAN TERRORISTS.

Introduced by Councilors RESTITUTO B. MALAÑGEN, BERNADETTE HERRERA-DY, ERIC Z. MEDINA, ANTONIO E. INTON, JR., RAMON P. MEDALLA, JORGE B. BANAL, JR., VOLTAIRE GODOFREDO L. LIBAN III, JOSEPH P. JUICO, FRANCISCO A. CALALAY, JR., JANET M. MALAYA and WINSTON "Winnie" T. CASTELO.

WHEREAS, a spate of bombing incidents recently rocked our country, such as bombings at the Ecoland Terminal in Davao and in General Santos City, and a bus explosion in Makati on February 14, 2005;

WHEREAS, while the authorities have yet to identify the real culprits behind the series of Metro Bombings, there is a general feeling of public anxiety now prevailing and a perceived inability of the government to protect the citizens from the strategy of urban terrorism;

WHEREAS, in Quezon City, there are establishments which may be potential targets of urban terrorists and other places where public usually congregate requiring tighter security measures that will provide protection to them;

WHEREAS, unless visible security measures are instituted, there is a growing concern not only to public safety but also to the viability of business within the City.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Central Police District (CPD) and the Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS) to formulate security measures in all commercial establishments, schools and other places which are potential targets of urban terrorists.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished the Central Police District (CPD) and the Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS).
