RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2944**, S-2005

A RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY TO SET UP A SCREENING STANDARD FOR THE RECRUITMENT OF ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO RENDERS PEACE AND ORDER DUTY, AND REQUIRING THEM TO UNDERGO TRAINING OR SEMINARS ON PEACE AND ORDER MANAGEMENT.

WHEREAS, the City government sees the need to set up a screening standard for the recruitment of any individual who renders peace and order duty so as to ensure that only those who are qualified shall be recruited and become members of the city's peace and order enforcement groups;

WHEREAS, to complement a good recruitment program, those who are recruited should also be required to undergo a continuing training or seminar on peace and order management;

WHEREAS, these standards when established, will surely enhance the image and efficiency of the city's peace and order enforcers towards transforming Quezon City to a peaceful and crime-free community.
