RESOLUTION NO. SP- 4981, S-2010

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE INTERNAL RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE 17TH CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY.

*Introduced by Councilors JESUS MANUEL C. SUNTAY and
GODOFREDO T. LIBAN II.*

WHEREAS, a set of rules of procedure is a fundamental necessity in a deliberative body such as the City Council, prescribing among others;

- 1. The organization of the sanggunian and the election of its officers;*
- 2. The creation of standing committees and election of chairpersons and members;*
- 3. The order and calendar of business for each session;*
- 4. The legislative process on the enactment and approval of ordinances and adoption of resolution;*
- 5. The parliamentary procedure which includes the conduct of members during session;*
- 6. The discipline of members for disorderly behavior and absences without justifiable cause for four (4) consecutive sessions;*

WHEREAS, conformably with Section 50 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Council is mandated to adopt or update its existing Internal Rules of Procedure to keep abreast with the changing times and facilitate legislative procedure.
