**A RESOLUTION URGING THE NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR CULTURE AND ARTS TO DECLARE MR. RODOLFO "DOLPHY" V. QUIZON AS NATIONAL ARTIST.**

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*WHEREAS, Mr. Rodolfo "Dolphy" V. Quizon started as a stage performer during the Japanese occupation of the Philippines;*

*WHEREAS, Dolphy was first known in his first movie in Sampaguita Pictures in 1953 entitled "Sa Isang Sulyap Mo Tita" which became a box office that paved the way to his starring role in the movie "Jack and Jill" with Lolita Rodriquez;*

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*WHEREAS, he made several box office comedy movies and television shows under his name and earned several awards such as the Year 2000 Cinemanila International Film Festival and 2009 Manila Film Festival "Lifetime Achievement Awards"; 1990 Manila Film Festival "Best Actor" in his movie Espadang Patpat; 1978 FAMAS Best Actor for "Omeng Santasia"; Bituin ng FAMAS Mula Noon Hanggang Ngayon Award; Named as the King of Philippine Movies (1979); Dangal ng Lipi Award by the Bert Marcelo Memorial Foundation and Lifetime Achievement by URIAN, a very prestigious award (1994); Named as one of the 100 influential Filipino Artists of the country by the Cultural Center of the Philippines (1999); Parangal ng Bayan and Golden Father Foundation Awardee; and many other awards and nominations from different prestigious award giving bodies in movie and television;*

*WHEREAS, as a producer, he produced several projects in both movie and television and had helped established the careers of Ronaldo Valdez and Alicia Alonzo;*

*WHEREAS, Dolphy is an icon of the Entertainment Industry and has earned the distinction of being the "Comedy King" of the Philippine Cinema;*

*WHEREAS, with his exemplary contribution to the Entertainment Industry, it is rightful that Mr. Rodolfo "Dolphy" V. Quizon be declared as a National Artist;*

*WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod expresses its support for Dolphy and urges the National Commission for Culture and Arts to declare Dolphy as a National Artist.*


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NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the National Commission for Culture and Arts to declare Mr. Rodolfo "Dolph" V. Quezon as National Artist.
