RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5045, S-2010

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO ENACT A LAW THAT SEEKS TO ESTABLISH AN INTERNET ACCESS FOR RESEARCH IN KEY STRATEGIC BARANGAYS NATIONWIDE TO ADDRESS THE BACKLOG OF PUBLIC LIBRARIES.

WHEREAS, said proposed Internet access for Research in key barangays will give students and the public easy access to reading materials which are necessary in the search for broader knowledge.


