RESOLUTION NO. SP- **5081**, S-2011

A RESOLUTION URGING ATTY. FRANCIS TOLENTINO, CHAIRMAN, METROPOLITAN MANILA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (MMDA) TO CONSTRUCT A STEEL FOOTBRIDGE ALONG ROAD 1 OF BARANGAY PROJECT 6 TO CROSS ROAD 8 OF BARANGAY BAGONG PAG-ASA, MINDANAO AVENUE, DISTRICT 1, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, under Section 16 of R.A. No. 7160, the General Welfare Clause of the Local Government Code, every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support the promotion of health and safety and preserve the comfort and convenience of its inhabitants;

WHEREAS, the pedestrians who intend to cross the aforementioned streets have no easy access to go from one side to the other side of such streets;

WHEREAS, at present, the only existing access to cross the above mentioned streets are along North Avenue, Road 3 of Barangay Project 6 near Canlobo Market to cross Road 16 of Barangay Bagong Pag-asa, and a U-turn slot in the middle of Mindanao Avenue, between Road 3 of Barangay Project 6 and Congressional Avenue;

WHEREAS, a footbridge will reduce the risk of accidents or injuries to pedestrians. Moreover, the establishment of a footbridge will decongest traffic and be a deterrent to any untoward incident or crime;

WHEREAS, to provide the pedestrians a convenient, safe and easy access to cross such streets, the construction of a steel footbridge is necessary at the aforementioned area.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge Atty. Francis Tolentino, Chairman, Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) to construct a steel footbridge along Road 1 of Barangay Project 6 to cross Road 8 of Barangay Bagong Pag-asa, Mindanao Avenue, District 1, Quezon City.
