RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5120, S-2011

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE FAMILY AND SURVIVING HEIRS OF THE LATE LUPONG TAGAPAMAYAPA MEMBER ADELAIDA B. DEUNA OF BARANGAY LIBIS, DISTRICT III, THIS CITY, IN THE AMOUNT OF FORTY THOUSAND PESOS (P40,000.00), AS PROVIDED FOR IN ORDINANCE NO. SP-1860, S-2008, AS AMENDED, TO BE CHARGED FROM THE APPROPRIATION FOR GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS UNDER THE 2011 ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY TREASURY.

WHEREAS, Lupong Tagapamayapa member Adelaida B. Deuna of Barangay Libis has met her untimely demise on December 9, 2010;

WHEREAS, her dedicated service to Barangay Libis as Lupong Tagapamayapa from 2007 to 2010 deserves recognition, as she earned the admiration and respect of her constituents, both as a public official and law-abiding citizen;

WHEREAS, the City Government, as a token of gratitude for the humble service of its Barangay Officials, should convey sympathy and condolences by extending financial assistance to the bereaved family of the late Lupong Tagapamayapa member Adelaida B. Deuna.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to extend, as it does hereby extend financial assistance to the family and surviving heirs of the late Lupon Tagapamayapa member Adelaida B. Deuna of Barangay Libis, District III, this City, in the amount of Forty Thousand Pesos (P40,000.00) as provided for in Ordinance No. SP-1860, S-2008, as amended, to be charged from Grants, Subsidies and Contributions under the 2011 Annual Budget of the Office of the City Mayor or from any available funds of the City Treasury.
