RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5251, s-2011

**A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING AND RATIFYING THE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO EXECUTE, SIGN AND DELIVER FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT THE SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICE AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT AND VARIOUS CONTRACTORS FOR THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF SEVEN HUNDRED EIGHTY MILLION THREE HUNDRED FORTY NINE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED ELEVEN PESOS AND FIFTY CENTAVOS (P780,349,411.50).**

*WHEREAS, the City government undertakes to provide efficient city-wide solid waste cleaning, collection and disposal system under a comprehensive environmental program pursuant to its mandate under Section 17 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;*

*WHEREAS, towards this end, the City is in need of service providers that can deliver solid waste cleaning, collection and disposal services in accordance with the City's desired parameters for the six (6) service areas of the City;*

WHEREAS, on 30 May 2011, a public competitive bidding for the procurement of solid waste cleaning, collection and disposal services (the "Project") for the six (6) areas was conducted in accordance with Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR);

WHEREAS, on 27 June 2011, the project was awarded to the following Contractors for the six (6) service areas with their corresponding winning bids, to wit:
