RESOLUTION NO. SP-5370, S-201

A RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO ALLOCATE A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND WITHIN THE QUEZON CITY HALL COMPLEX CONSISTING OF FOUR THOUSAND (4,000) SQUARE METERS PREFERABLY CONTIONALONG EAST AVENUE TO BE USED AS THE SITE FOR A MULTI-LEVEL CAR PARK BUILDING FOR THE BENEFIT OF GOVERNMENT LEVEL CAR PARK BUILDING PRIVATE INDIVIDUALS TRANSACTING EMPLOYEES INCLUDING PRIVATE INDIVIDUALS TRANSACTING BUSINESS WITHIN THE CITY HALL COMPLEX.

WHEREAS, employees of the Quezon City Government and private individuals transacting business within the Quezon City Hall complex are having difficulty in parking their vehicles due to the insufficiency of parking spaces within the complex;

WHEREAS, this inadequacy can be attributed to the: (1) construction of new buildings, (2) increase in the number of government employees stationed in or assigned in said new buildings, and (3) increasing number of individuals transacting business at the Hall of Fustice and City Government's Offices;

WHEREAS, this problem of limited parking spaces which sometimes result in traffic congestion within the complex can be minimized, if not totally resolved, by constructing a multi-level car park building within City Hall complex without adversely affecting the over all perspective view of the complex;

WHEREAS, there were proposed resolutions allocaing a certain portion of City Hall compound and the Honorable City Mayor was even authorized to enter a Build-Operate Transfer scheme for the construction of the multi-level car park building, however the same were not finally approved up to this date;

WHEREAS, the problem of the insufficient parking space has become a perennial problem within the City Hall complex, especially during renewal of business permits, payment of business and real property taxes.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUETON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby tree the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert Bautista, to allocate a certain procel of land within the Quezon City Hall Complex consisting of four thousand (4,000) square meters, preferably that portion along East Avenue, to be used as the site for a multi-level car park building for the benefit of government employees including private individuals transacting business within the Quezon City Hall complex.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to authorize the Honorable City Mayor to enter into a Build-Operate-Transfer scheme with a reputable private firm or allocate the necessary funds from his Honor's special projects funds in the 2012 Annual Budget for the construction of the above mentioned car park building.
