RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5516, S-2012

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, THROUGH THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES AND ITS NATIONAL TELEHEALTH CENTER, REPRESENTED BY ITS PRESIDENT ALFREDO E. PASCUAL, ON THE COMPUTERIZED HEALTH INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SYSTEM (CHITS) FOR THE QUEZON CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, in 1998, the University of the Philippines (U.P.) created the National TeleHealth Center (NTHC), with the objective of improving the health of Filipinos through the appropriate use of information and communications technology, which includes health informatics and health Information Technology (IT);

WHEREAS, in accordance with its mandate, the NTHC has, over the years, designed and implemented various research projects among which is the Community Health Information Tracking System (CHITS), which is a web-based health record management system specifically developed for government health centers aimed at consolidating research-based health information;

WHEREAS, U.P. is the sole and exclusive service and maintenance provider of the CHITS;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government, through its City Health Department, is desirous of engaging the services of U.P. to implement the CHITS for its primary health care centers pursuant to its Computerized Health Information project, which are comprised of the following:

- 1. customization and development of modules based on DOH Health Programs and Quezon City Health forms and reports;*
- 2. capability-building programs for end-users, facility administrators and IT personnel;*
- 3. installation and configuration of CHITS into two (2) central servers for the Quezon City Information Technology and Development Office (QC-ITDO); and*
- 4. other technical support and related services.*

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Agreement was entered into between the Quezon City Government, represented by the Honorable City Mayor Herbert M. Bautista, and the University of the Philippines and its National TeleHealth Center, represented by its president, Alfredo E. Pascual to actualize the Computerized Health Information project;

WHEREAS, said Memorandum of Agreement contains favorable terms and conditions for both parties;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 455 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code, ratification of the Quezon City Council is a pre-requisite for the Memorandum of Agreement to take effect.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to ratify, as it does hereby ratify the Memorandum of Agreement of the Quezon City Government, through the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, with the University of the Philippines and its National TeleHealth Center, represented by its president, Alfredo E. Pascual, on the Computerized Health Information Technology System (CHITS) for the Quezon City Health Department.
