RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5536, S-2012

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO EXTEND THE SERVICE AGREEMENTS FOR THE SOLID WASTE CLEANING, COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL PROJECT ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT AND VARIOUS CONTRACTORS, WHICH WILL EXPIRE ON JUNE 30, 2012, FOR SIX (6) MONTHS OR FROM JULY 1, 2012 UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2012.**

*WHEREAS, on May 30, 2011, the Bids and Awards Committee-Goods of the Quezon City Government conducted the public competitive bidding for the procurement of solid waste cleaning, collection and disposal services for Service Areas I, II-A, II-B, II-C, III and IV;*

*WHEREAS, on July 27, 2011, the project was awarded to the following Contractors for the said six (6) service areas with their corresponding winning bids, to wit:*

*WHEREAS, the corresponding Service Agreements for Solid Waste Cleaning, Collection and Disposal Project for the six (6) Service Areas were executed and entered into by and between the Quezon City Government and the aforementioned contractors for a period of one (1) year, or from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012;*

*WHEREAS, in its Resolution No. 12-004E, the Bids and Awards Committee-Goods resolves to recommend to and for the approval by the City Mayor the extension of the Service Agreements for six (6) months or July 1, 2012 until December 31, 2012 with the City's Contracted Haulers pending completion of the revised Terms of Reference (TOR) so as to maintain the status quo in the meantime and to prevent interruption in the solid waste cleaning, collection and disposal operation that would otherwise be detrimental to the general welfare of the City;*


*WHEREAS, considering therefore that the said service agreements will expire on June 30, 2012, there is a need to authorize the City Mayor to extend the service agreements for six (6) months, or from July 1, 2012 until December 31, 2012, in order to continue the City government's undertaking of providing efficient city-wide solid waste cleaning, collection and disposal system under the comprehensive environmental program pursuant to its mandate under Section 17 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991. ✓*


