A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (DepEd) TO CONSIDER THE USE OF ALTERNATIVE MATERIALS OR ENVIRONMENT FRIENDLY MATERIALS FOR SCHOOL FURNITURE IN ALL PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND HIGH SCHOOL IN QUEZON CITY AS PART OF THE GREEN INITIATIVES OF THIS CITY.

WHEREAS, environment friendly refers to products and/or recycled materials that contribute to green living or practices that help conserve our natural resources;


WHEREAS, considering the use of alternative recycled or environment friendly materials for school furniture in line with the Quezon City Government's goal of environmental friendly city and more importantly to preserve the trees that would have been use in making school furniture.

NOW, THEREFORE,


