RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5593 , S-2012,

A RESOLUTION ENJOINING ALL BARANGAYS IN QUEZON CITY TO PRACTICE THE 4 O'CLOCK COMMUNITY CLEANING HABIT AND TO INSTILL THE 4S: SEARCH AND DESTROY BREEDING PLACES, SEEK EARLY TREATMENT, SELF-PRODUCTIVE MEASURES AND SAY YES TO FOGGING ONLY DURING OUTBREAKS IN THE PREVENTION DENGUE IN THEIR COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, Dengue Fever is an acute febrile viral disease caused by dengue viruses. Dengue viruses are transmitted to humans through the bites of infective female Aedes mosquitoes. Dengue Fever is an acute febrile infection characterized by sudden onset, fever for 3-5 days, intense headache, muscle pain, joint pain, eye pain, anorexia, gastrointestinal disturbances and rash. Untreated Dengue haemorrhagic fever can be fatal;

WHEREAS, one of the best way to prevent sickness is for the community to be educated on how to avoid them. Safety measures must be taken every day to protect the people against life-threatening mosquito bites and other diseases. Various diseases can be prevented if the people are educated on how to prevent them and protect themselves from the causes of these diseases;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to enjoin, as it does hereby enjoin all Barangays in Quezon City to practice the 4 o'clock community cleaning habit. By 4:00 p.m., there will be a simultaneous cleaning of surroundings in order to eliminate the breeding habits of mosquitoes.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to enjoin all Barangays of Quezon City to instill the 4S in the prevention of dengue in their community, that is:

- 1. Search and destroy breeding places
- 2. Seek early treatment
- 3. Self-productive measures
- 4. Say yes to fogging only during outbreaks.
