RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5595, S-2012,

A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY URGING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA TO FORM A "TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP" TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY AND PRESENT CONCRETE PLANS AND PROGRAMS NECESSARY FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE QUEZON CITY PUBLIC SLAUGHTERHOUSE.

WHEREAS, Section 458 (5) of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides: "The City shall approve Ordinances which shall ensure the efficient and effective delivery of basic services and facilities as provided for under Section 17 of this Code, and in addition to said services and facilities, shall: xxx (ii) establish markets slaughterhouses or animal corrals and authorize the operation thereof by the City Government xxx";

WHEREAS, Section 17 of the Code enumerated the basic services and facilities that should be provided by the City, such services and facilities include "Public Markets Slaughterhouses" and other city enterprises;

WHEREAS, the establishment of public slaughterhouses will not only serve the residents of Quezon City by providing clean, orderly, effective and efficient public slaughterhouse services but most its operation would increase the revenue collection of the City, hence, it will serve as a sustainable source of income for the Quezon City Government;

WHEREAS, a publicly owned slaughterhouse will provide affordable and quality, thus, ensuring public health.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby earnestly urge the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista to form a "Technical Working Group" (TWG) in order to study the feasibility and present concrete plans and programs necessary for the establishment of a public slaughterhouse.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Technical Working Group shall have the following duties and responsibilities;

First, to conduct feasibility study by taking into account the following:

- a. Advantages of establishing a public slaughterhouse.*
- b. Necessity of establishing the same.*
- c. Identify most viable site where the public slaughterhouse may be established.*


Second, submit initial feasibility study to the City Mayor and City Council within thirty (30) days after its creation.

Third, submit its final feasibility study for the establishment of Quezon City Slaughterhouse.


RESOLVED, FURTHERMORE, that copy of this resolution be furnished the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista for his information and reference.
