RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5605 , S-2012

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE THIRTY NINE (39) FAMILIES AFFECTED BY FIRE THAT RAZED A RESIDENTIAL AREA ON FEBRUARY 26, 2012 AT BARANGAY LOYOLA HEIGHTS, DISTRICT III, THIS CITY AT TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) PER FAMILY OWNER AND ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) PER FAMILY RENTER/SHARER WHICH SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE CALAMITY OR EMERGENCY FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR FROM ANY OTHER AVAILABLE FUNDS IN THE CITY TREASURY.

WHEREAS, Section 458 (1) (iv) of the Local Government Code of 1991 empowered the Sangguniang Panlungsod "to adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the City from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities and in their return to productive livelihood following said events".

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista to extend financial assistance to the Thirty Nine (39) families affected by fire that razed a residential area on February 26, 2012 at Barangay Loyola Heights. District III, this City at Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) per family owner and One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) per family renter/sharer which shall be taken from the Calamity or Emergency Fund of the City Government or from any other available funds in the City."

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Social Services Development Department in coordination with the Barangay Officials of Barangay Loyola Heights shall authenticate the beneficiaries of this assistance.
