WHEREAS, on March 26, 2012, the Quezon City Council unanimously confirmed the appointment of Victor B. Endriga, Ph.D, as co-terminus City Administrator of Quezon City for the period of January 1 to December 31, 2012;

WHEREAS, with the expiration of the period of appointment of Dr. Endriga, it is fitting that he be reappointed as City Administrator for consistently proving his worth and dedication in our beloved city through his service;

WHEREAS, Dr. Victor Endriga holds a Doctorate Degree in Fiscal Studies and a Masters Degree in Public Administration, Major in Government Management, and has completed as a special study in Fiscal Decentralization and Fiscal Management of Regional and Local Government from the Harvard Institute for International Development or John F. Kennedy School of Government of the prestigious Harvard University;

WHEREAS, in his forty-three (43) years in public service, which is marked by competence, integrity, honesty, probity and independence, Dr. Endriga has held significant positions in the Office of the City Treasurer, such as Assistant City Treasurer of Manila, and City Treasurer of Pasig and Quezon City;
