A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE QUEZON CITY GENERAL HOSPITAL PRIORITY EXPENDITURES PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY GENERAL HOSPITAL TO USE TWO HUNDRED FORTY NINE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED PESOS (P249,461,600.00) OF THE HOSPITAL DEVELOPMENT FUND (HDF) FOR THE PROGRAM SUBJECT TO GOVERNMENT AUDITING AND ACCOUNTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Republic Act No. 6548, the QCGH Hospital Development Fund shall be used, with the approval of the City Council, for additional operational operating expenses, including purchase of equipment, improvement of existing hospital facilities and construction and/or expansion of buildings;

WHEREAS, the QCGH has a proposed Priority Program for the development of the hospital facilities to further improve the delivery of health services to the residents of Quezon City.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to approve, as it does hereby approve the Quezon City General Hospital Priority Development Program, as follows:

c.Mammography	35,000.000.00
d.Incubator (6 units)	10,000,000.00
<b>Total</b>	P249,461,600.00
