WHEREAS, FIBA Asia, the governing body for basketball in the continent of Asia, holds biennially the FIBA Asia Championship, which in turn serves as the qualifier for the FIBA Basketball World Cup (formerly known as the FIBA World Championship of Basketball);

WHEREAS, the 27th FIBA Asia Championship, held from August 1 to 11, 2013, was hosted by the Philippines with games held at the Mall of Asia Arena, Pasay City and the Ninoy Aquino Memorial Stadium, Manila and participated in by the Asian countries of Iran, Qatar, Kazakhstan, Jordan, Nahrain, Saudi Arabia, India, Japan, Malaysia, South Korea, Chinese-Taipei, China, Hong Kong and the Philippines;

WHEREAS, the Philippines won the Silver Medal in the said tournament;

WHEREAS, the said Silver Medal is the first medal of the Philippines in the said tournament since it last won a medal in the 1986 Asian Championship for Men (the predecessor of the FIBA Asia Championship), held from December 28, 1985 to January 5, 1986 in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia;

WHEREAS, having won the said tournament, the Philippines now qualifies for the 2014 Basketball World Cup to be held in Spain;

WHEREAS, Quezon City is proud for the exemplary accomplishments of the Gilas Pilipinas men's basketball team in winning the tournament and for overcoming an insurmountable obstacle with pride, sheer determination and heart:
