RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5785, S-2013

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO PURCHASE FIVE (5) UNITS OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE MILLION FIFTY THOUSAND AND TWO HUNDRED PESOS (PHP5,050,200.00) INTENDED FOR THE SPEEDY DISCHARGE OF OFFICIAL DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE QUEZON CITY POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY (QCPU) CHARGEABLE AGAINST THE CONTINUING APPROPRIATION OF THE CITY MAYOR.

*WHEREAS, it is the mandate of the 1987 Philippine Constitution that the State shall give priority to education, science and technology, arts, culture, and sports to foster patriotism and nationalism, accelerate social progress, and promote total human liberation and development;*

WHEREAS, it is through the local government units that the State effectively carry on the above-cited provision in lieu of the fact that the State also insures autonomy of these local governments;

WHEREAS, it is provided for by Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, that the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panglungsod pursuant to a law or an ordinance;

WHEREAS, in order to achieve efficiency and timely delivery of the required educational services to their student body, the Quezon City Polytechnic University (QCPU) proposed for the procurement of five (5) units of motor vehicle amounting to five million fifty thousand and two hundred pesos (Php 5,050,200.00) chargeable against the Continuing Appropriation of the City Mayor, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the four units pertain to an AUV with 2.5 liter diesel and 4 cylinders with the following specifications:

- Tread front/rear 1,510 / 1,510
- min. turning radius 5.4
- Fuel tank capacity 55
- Seating capacity 8
- Curb weight 1665
- Model MKD-FTV
- Engine technology direct injection four-stroke common rail diesel (D-4D)
- Type 2.5 liter diesel, 4-cylinder, in-line 16V, double overhead camshaft (turbo charged)
- Displacement 2494
- Maximum output PS P<sub>g</sub> in 102/3600
- Maximum torque (br/ton A/T. 200/1600-2400
- Bore and stroke 92.0 x 73.8
- Compression ratio 18.0:1
- Fuel system direct injection common-rail
- Exhaust emission Euro 3 compliant;

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- Color: white
- Year model: 2011 MKD-FTV (hi)
- Double wishbone with coil springs/right axle leaf spring ventilated discs/leading-trailing drum supported by a 205/70 R15 6JJ x 15 alloy torque of 200 Nm/1400-3,400Rpm; 102Ps/3600 and a max. over fuel system is direct injection common-rail, Euro II color keyed with reflector (halogen 2 bulb) with Integrated clearance and turn lamp  
The front seat reclining, sliding and height.  
Adjuster (driver) with back pocket  
Integrate rear global outstanding assessment (GOA) body, driver airbag Dr. & Fr. Seatbelt warning, child lock protector side door impact beams & ABS for reliable safety.

*WHEREAS, the purchase of the said vehicles shall be used by QCPU in its operations and in the speedy discharge of its official duties and functions, considering that it has three (3) campuses located in Novaliches, North EDSA and Batasan and the distance of these campuses require for vehicular support for all departments of the University;*

*WHEREAS, having more than 3,000 students increasing annually and more or less 350 staff and faculty, these vehicles are vital in transporting said individuals during important activities and events;*

*WHEREAS, the Honorable City Mayor already sought the authority of the Secretary of DILG (pertaining to the acquisition of motor vehicles by LGU sourced from local funds) prescribed under Section 9.0 of EO No. 233) and the only requirement necessary for its completion is a legislative issuance authorizing the City Mayor to purchase the same;*


**NOW, THEREFORE,**


