RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5789 S-2013

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE STRICT IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROCEDURE FOR THE APPLICATION OF FRANCHISE FOR MARKETS AND SLAUGHTERHOUSES AND SPECIAL PERMITS FOR TLANGGES AS PROVIDED BY ORDINANCE NO. SP-1786, S-2007 AND ORDINANCE NO. SP-944, S-2000, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE QUEZON CITY MARKET CODE, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. SP-1520, S-2005.

WHEREAS, Section 458 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the Sangguniang Panlungsod, as the legislative body of the City, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the City and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the City as provided for under Section 22 of this Code, and shall ...(3) Subject to the provisions of Book II of this Code, enact ordinances granting franchises and authorizing the issuance of permits or licenses, upon such conditions and for such purposes intended to promote the general welfare of the inhabitants of the City;

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WHEREAS, the same Code provides further that upon approval by a majority vote of all the members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, grant a franchise to any person, partnership, corporation, or cooperative to do business within the city; establish, construct, operate and maintain ferries, wharves, markets or slaughterhouses, or undertake such other activities within the City as may be allowed by existing law;

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. SP-944, S-2000 provides for the Quezon City Market Code regulating the establishment classification, operation and the administration of government and privately owned/operated public markets and all other market-related activities such as slaughterhouses and hawkers in the City;

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. SP-944, S-2000, as amended by City Ordinance No. SP-1520, S-2005 provides that no person, partnership or corporation shall operate a private market, talipapa, flea market and/or vending area or slaughterhouses within Quezon City without first securing a franchise and/or permit from the City Council and that all applications to operate a privately-owned market and slaughterhouse shall be filed with the Quezon City Market Development and Administration Department;

WHEREAS, Section 3 of City Ordinance No. SP-1786, S-2007 provides that it shall be unlawful for an organizer or exhibitor to operate a tiangge with Quezon City without first securing a special permit from the City Council at least sixty (60) days before the start of the tiangge, in addition to the regular business permit issued by the City government;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Market Development and Administration Department is given the authority to deny any application or order the closure of any market, slaughterhouse or tiangge which has failed to comply with the requirements in securing the necessary permits or has violated any provisions pertinent to their operation;

WHEREAS, there is a need to strictly implement the abovementioned requirements and for all concerned parties to follow the procedure as prescribed by the Quezon City Market Development and Administration Department:

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NOW, THERERFORE,

REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to support, as it does hereby support the strict implementation of the procedure for the application of franchise for markets and slaughterhouses and special permits for transges as provided by Ordinance No. SP-1786, S-2007 and Ordinance No. SP-944, S-2000, otherwise known as the Quezon City Market Code, as amended by Ordinance No. SP-1520, S-2005.
