RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5812, S-2013

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE EUGENIO M. BACUITA, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE MEMORIAL LIBRARY OF JOMALIG, QUEZON IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (PHP300,000.00) INTENDED FOR THE REPAIR AND REHABILITATION OF ITS READING CENTER TO PROVIDE THE STUDENTS THEREIN WITH A CONDUCTIVE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT CHARGEABLE AGAINST THE DONATIONS ACCOUNT OF THE CITY MAYOR FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014.

WHEREAS, it is provided in under the 1987 Philippine Constitution
that the State shall give priority in education, science and technology, arts,
culture and sports to foster nationalism and nationalistic sentiments, social
progress, and promote social justice, liberalism and development.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the above-mentioned provision, the Quezon City Government gives adherence and priority to quality education as well as to the molding of the young minds into the path of excellence and wisdom;

WHEREAS, it is also one of the objectives of the Quezon City Government to extend educational services and assistance not just to its constituents but even, to other local government units as well, in order to attain the policy of the State to recognize the vital role of the youth in nation-building and to promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being;

WHEREAS, one of the local government units that the Quezon City Government would like to continuously reach out, through the Quezon City Public Library (QCPL), is the Municipality of Jomalig, Quezon;

WHEREAS, considering that Jomalig, is a 5th class municipality and remote to the town proper, access to beneficial educational reading materials and favorable learning centers is scarce;

WHEREAS, if the Quezon City Government will allow the grant of financial assistance to Jomalig, Quezon, the same will surely improve the quality of lives of the people therein and the generosity shown by the City will certainly be remembered;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, states that "inter-local government loans, grants and subsidies - provinces, cities and municipalities may, upon approval of the majority of all members of the Sanggunian concerned and in the amount not exceeding their surplus funds, extend loans, grants, subsidies to other local government units under such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon by the contracting parties";

WHEREAS, it is also the mandate of the same Code that the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance;

WHEREAS, the City Budget Officer and the City Accountant of the Quezon City Government interpose no objection to the approval of said authorization. X


NOW, THEREFORE,
