RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5835, S-2013,

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF LIGHT EMITTING DIODE (LED) AND CONTROL PANEL SYSTEM INTENDED FOR EFFICIENT STREETLIGHTING SYSTEM IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", the City Mayor is empowered to represent the City in all its business transactions and to sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to a law or ordinance;

WHEREAS, faithful to its mandate in Section 458 (a) (5) (v) of the same Code and to ensure effective and efficient delivery of basic services to its constituents such as, but not limited to, providing sufficient streetlight system within the City;

WHEREAS, the City Government undertakes the facilitation of upgrading the streetlight system from the existing High Pressure Sodium Light (HPS) system to Light Emitting Diode (LED) energy efficient system;

WHEREAS, the measure sought to be implemented will not only aid in keeping the streets of the City safe for the public at all times, especially at night but will also make the streetlight system more economical, durable and environment-friendly;

WHEREAS, necessary for the implementation of the subject project, the Office of the City Mayor is requesting for the authorization to enter into a contract for the purchase of the following:

Cluster 1:

- *Seven Hundred Thirty (730) sets of \leq 75 watts LED luminaire amounting to Nineteen Million Seven Hundred Ten Thousand Pesos (Php 19,710,000.00); and*
- *A control panel system amounting to One Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 1,500,000.00)*

Cluster 2:

- *Two hundred nineteen (219) sets of \leq 75 watts LED Luminaire amounting to Five Million Nine Hundred Thirteen Thousand Pesos (Php 5,913,000.00);*

WHEREAS, the City Budget Department has certified that there is an Approved Budget Contract (ABC) for this project;

WHEREAS, the purchase of the aforementioned materials will be used by the City project implementor in accordance with the provided specifications in the areas of Barangays South Triangle, Obrero, Sacred Heart, Kamuning, Roxas, Paligsahan, Laging Handa and Panay Avenue (Cluster 1) as well as in the areas of Barangays Bungad, Nayong Kinluran, Sta. Cruz and West Triangle (Cluster 2).


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN A SPECIAL SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bauista, to enter into a contract for the purchase of light emitting diode (LED) luminaires and control panel system intended for the replacement and upgrading of the streetlight system in Quezon City; χ


