WHEREAS, the award is given to individuals, nongovernment organizations, private sectors and government organizations, in recognition of their initiative in helping the Filipino government uplift the standard of disaster management in the country;

WHEREAS, on December 9, 2016 Undersecretary Thomas M. Orbos, General Manager of Metropolitan Manila Development Authority and Officer-In-Charge, Metro Manila Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council, awarded the Plaque of Recognition to Barangay Sto. Cristo Quezon City for the best Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction Management (BDRRM) Committee;

WHEREAS, Section 12 (a) of Republic Act No. 10121 mandates the establishment of LDRRMO in every province, city and municipality, and a Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Committee (BDRRMC) in every barangay which shall be responsible for setting the direction, development, implementation and coordination of disaster risk management programs within their territorial jurisdiction;
